BAIRRADA Region

Region: Plane region extended on the west coastline. Green hills and small property. Forest (pynes and eucalyptus). **Clay-limestone** soils and **sandy areas**. The Atlantic influence is kept / protected / emphasized by the geographical barrier of 3 mountains (Caramulo, Bussaco and Lousã) in the east boarder with Dão region.

Climate: Notorious maritime influence from the Atlantic. The winter is cold, long and rainy and in Summer the days are warm, with cold nights and significant humidity. Those conditions allow slow maturation, conserving the grapes' natural acidity, resulting in elegant and gastronomic wines, full of character and with great longevity.

Main grapes:

BAGA is the queen grape variety of the region, extremely versatile: with it it's possible to produce rich and full of character reds, elegant and aromatic roses, classic method sparkling wines as blanc de noirs, rose and red, and also elegant fortified wines.

White - Maria Gomes, Arinto, Bical and Cercial.

Red - Baga, Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz, Castelão.

Wines: the cold and humid climate favours the production of **excellent classic method sparkling wines**, in which the region is a pioneer in Portugal since the XIX Century; the **reds** are firm, rich in red fruits and with great ageing potential; the **whites** are fresh, fruity and elegant.

Main Red Grapes

Baga

[Ba-ga or Bug-uh]



- Originally from Bairrada, produces full-bodied, tannic and complex wines

- clear flavors of berries and black plums and hints of coffee and tobacco;

- wines age remarkably well, softening and gaining remarkable complexity.

- also used as a base for classic method sparkling wines red, rose and *blanc de noirs*

Touriga Nacional

[Too-REE-gah Nass-eyon-nal]



- High concentration of sweetness, aromas, tannins and colour

- With aromas of dark berry fruits, notes of pine, eucalyptus and rockrose

Aragonez

[Ara-goo-nez]



- The same as Tinta Roriz or Tempranillo

- produces fruity, dark and aromatic wines

- rich, lively red wines that combine elegance and robustness, copious berry fruit and spicy flavour

Main White Grapes

Fernão Pires

[Fair-NOW PEE-ress]



- In Bairrada also known as Maria Gomes
- The most planted white variety in Bairrada
- Very versatile grape: great for still and sparkling wines
- Crisp, and very aromatic whites with notes of yellow, citrus and white flowers



Arinto

[Ah-rin-too]



- Balanced and refreshing acidity resulting in vibrant wines;
- Mineral and aromatic, hints of lemon, apple and pineapple
- With ageing potential and great ability for sparkling wines

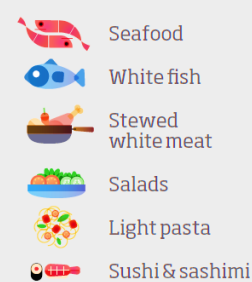


Bical

[Bi-cal]



- Originally from Bairrada region;
- Good acidity, specially soft and aromatic wines, fresh and well structured, typically with aromas of peach and apricot
- With great ability for sparkling wines, to which, in Bairrada, is often used blended with Arinto

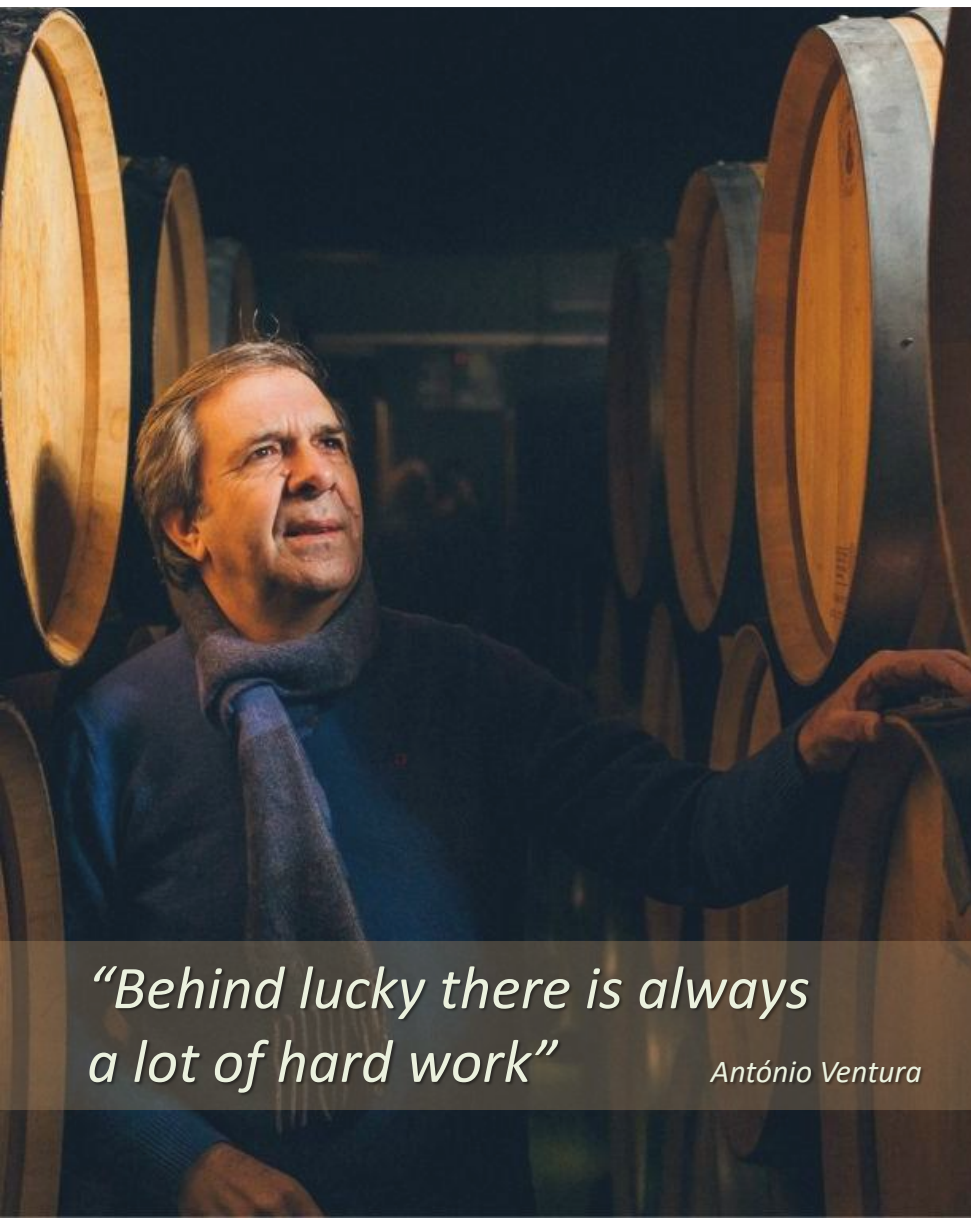

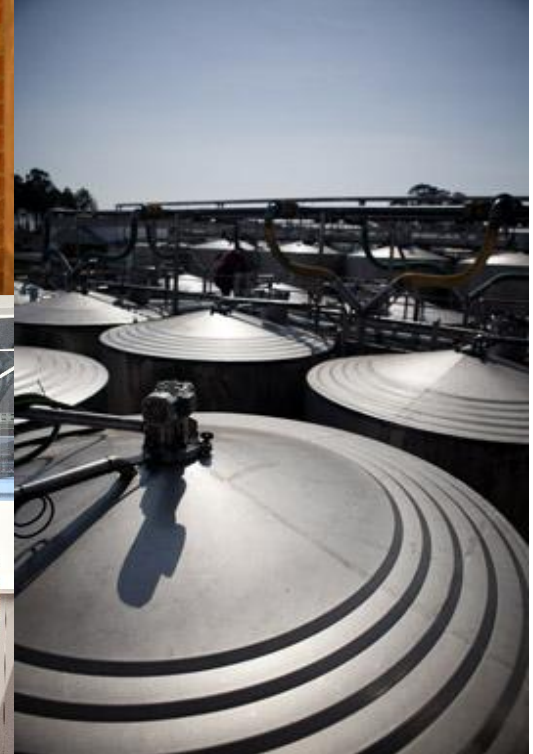
